(‘ *Akəsosəya* is a loanword from Greek ἔξουσία “authority”. There is a passage ascribed to Cyril of Alexandria which says አክሶሲያ ፡ ዘይደሉ ፡ ለመለኮት ፡ (ቁር ፡ ስምዓት) ። “authority that belongs to the divinity”, cf. Kidāna Wald Kəfle 1955, 220.’ Tedros Abraha 2015, 135 (431) n. 286)
