መልሐ፡ *malləḥa* I,2 ይሚልሐ, ይመልሐ፡ «*assaisonner*» — አጣፈጠ፡ Ms. {DiLBNFabb217}, fol.33r. Grébaut 1952, 74

Leslau

መልሐ *malləḥa* season with salt, make tasty (denominative of *malḥ*); note that G. መልሐ *malḥa* or *malləḥa* is also rendered by Tāyya, <i>^oAlaqa</i> 1965, 37 and [Tasfā Šəllāse] 1945, 9 ‘do, work’ (also KG *məḥ* ‘work’), possibly ‘do good work’, salt being the symbol of good deeds. It could also be that መልሐ *malḥa* is for vid. መልኅ *malḥa* below, and the general meaning ‘do, work’ refers to all the activities expressed by *malḥa*. Leslau 1987, 343
