(plant) ‘Forma mancante in Dillmann, che registra «nug» {vid. ኑግ ፣}, Dillmann 1865, 675, come corrispondente amarico del ge‘ez «malans» (Guidi 1901, 397; Kane 1990, 1059); registrato da Leslau 1987, 394b; cf. tigrino «niguh», Da Bassano 1918, 439 e tigrè «nehig», Littmann and Höfner 1962, 323. nəḥigw ንሂገ (Dästa Täklä Wäld 1969, 837), *nəḥigw* ንሂገ (Lt) ‘leguminous plant that has oily seeds’; ‘(*qəb^ea nəḥigw* oil made from the nəḥigw-plant’; is used for cooking, especially during the fasting period) Leslau 1987, 394b
